ENERGY MYTHS EXPLAINED:

All energy audits are the same.

FALSE While most utility companies offer FREE energy audits, they only offer visual inspections. The same can be said about building inspections. Finding a legitimate home performance contractor can be more difficult than it should be. Synergy is a BPI (Building Performance Institute) certified contractor committed to work according to BPI Standards.

Energy audits are expensive.

FALSE The cost is \$0.15/square foot of conditioned space with a \$350 minimum charge per house. For example, a 3,000 sq ft home x \$0.15 = \$450, a small investment to TEST the efficiencies of your home.

New windows and doors are the best way to achieve energy-efficiency.

FALSE While upgrading windows and doors are helpful, the top three upgrades to achieve energy-efficiency in your home are **air sealing**, **attic insulation** and **duct sealing**. Air sealing your home's building envelope (the shell) is a fundamental step in stopping air leakage. Proper attic insulation provides your home with a continuous thermal barrier. And your duct system is responsible for distributing conditioned air throughout your home. All three are huge contributors to energy loss.
